- 2) Examination of a cadaver to determine or confirm the cause of death.
- 3) One of the minute blood vessels that form a network in the body to interchange various substances, such as oxygen and carbon dioxide.
- 4) Either of two slender bones in human beings that extend below the neck; also called the collarbone.
- 5) An injury in which the skin is not broken; a bruise.
- 6) The strip of hardened skin at the base and sides of a fingernail or toenail.
- 7) To cut apart or separate, especially for anatomical study.
- 8) An organism in its early stages of development, especially before it has reached a distinctively recognizable form.
- 9) Bodily limbs or appendages; hands or feet.
- 10) Carrying developing offspring within the body.
- 11) Of, relating to, or affecting the lungs.
- 12) To return to health or strength; to recover.
- 13) To break open or burst.
- 14) The part of the human leg between the knee and ankle, or the part in the legs of other vertebrates.
- 15) Relating to, situated in, or affecting the soft internal organs of the body or intestines.
